What to bring

- SALT Adult Liability Release** for every adult (a page of Adult Liability Contact Form)
- SALT Youth Liability Release** for every youth (a page of Youth Liability Contact Form)
- Personal items
 - Long pants, long sleeved shirts, sweatshirt, t-shirts, sturdy closed-toed work shoes or boots, work gloves, soap, shampoo, bug spray, sunblock, wash cloth, towel, sheets, pillow, blankets (depending on housing arrangements).
 - Cell phone for keeping in contact and with group with SALT staff
- Tools (depending on skill level of the group)
 - Everyone should have: (*SALT has extra work gloves, safety goggles, and masks*)
 - Gloves
 - Hammer
 - Tape Measure
 - Helpful for Teams to have (depending on the skill level of the group):
 - Dust masks
 - Safety glasses or goggles
 - Circular Saw
 - Framing squares
 - T-square
 - Electric drill
 - Battery drill
 - Caulk line
 - Reciprocating saw
 - paint brushes, scrapers, rollers
 - Any tools that are specific to a skilled volunteer's trade (ie tile cutter for tiler, electrical or plumbing tools)
- Donations (see attached **Wish list**)

- Please have your group report to the Volunteer HQ at 9am on your first day of service. The Volunteer HQ is located next to the Schoharie Reformed Church at 256 Main Street, Schoharie, NY 12157. Park in the large parking lot behind the Church.
- Your group will be greeted and given an orientation and site assignment for the day.
